# Practical Nursing Program

Terrace and Prince Rupert Campuses | October 2024

The two-year Practical Nursing Program is designed to provide learners with the knowledge, skills, judgments, and attitudes to perform to the full range of competencies as identified by the British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM). The program provides a learning experience that is integrated, professional, collaborative and culturally sensitive with an aim to prepare graduates to care for individuals at multiple life stages and in a variety of practice settings. Program delivery will be a blend of in-person lab work and videoconferencing and includes a 180-hour practicum.

This program is available for international admissions. International students currently residing in Canada or abroad should apply for fall 2024 intake as soon as possible.

## Admission Requirements

The program has both admissions and practicum requirements to be met. Admissions requirements are for program entry (Step 1), and practicum requirements are to be completed in advance for clinical and lab class work (Step 2).

### Step 1:

- Completion of Senior Secondary school
- Senior Secondary Math with a minimum grade of 60%
- English 12 or equivalent with a minimum grade of 65%
- Senior Secondary Biology with a minimum grade of 60%
- Successful completion of either IELTS or CELBAN
- Completion of a supplementary course PNUR 103 Human Anatomy & Physiology for Practical Nurses with a minimum grade of 65%

### Step 2 (due within one month of program start date):

- Criminal Record Check
- Immunization Records (with a completed immunization form)
- Negative TB skin test or chest x-ray
- CPR level C
